LINDA COMMUNITY SCHOOL

One of the 20 Edulution Learning Centres is located at Linda Community School.

Linda provides a safe learning environment for 3,000 children from vulnerable backgrounds.

The School is located in Chilanga District, just outside Lusaka. The area is heavily impacted by high poverty rates, unemployment, and drug abuse.

EDULUTION

In 2016, Edulution launched the Numeracy Catch-up Programme at Linda Community School, and has to date, served over 2,600 learners to gain essential numeracy and ICT skills.

Headteacher Doreen Nzila started at Linda in 2015 and is proud of the excellent work Edulution is doing. Since Programme started, Linda has seen a dramatic increase in examination Pass grades: from 10% to 70%. Showing that the Learners are gaining a grip in mathematics that sets them up for their future.

MEMORY

Memory is a PestalozziWorld alumni from the north of Zambia who found a career and her calling at Edulution. In 2017, Patson was a Learner at Linda but dropped out of School. Headteacher Doreen and others helped Patson return and enrolled him in the Edulution Programme.

As he learned basic numeracy skills, he started to thrive and achieved a distinction in Mathematics at the end of the year National Exam.

In 2022, Patson became an assistant Edulution Coach and in 2023, he enrolled with a full scholarship at the University of Zambia.


